COUNSELOR CONTRACT**

I, _____, agree to the following conditions for maintaining my position as a Counselor for Vacation Church Camp, June 3-7, 2019.

I WILL BE ON TIME EACH DAY: Camp runs from 9:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. daily. Holy Communion Youth should arrive by 8:00 a.m. You may leave each day at 3:00p.m., after the children are picked up, and Lunt Hall/Miller Hall and the church grounds are clean.

I WILL DO MY PART TO MAINTAIN THE CHURCH AND CHURCH GROUNDS: As a group, you will be responsible for making sure that Miller Hall and any other room or building used is picked up and swept. The property will be left neat and orderly at the end of each camp day. This includes the church grounds outside.

I WILL SET AN EXAMPLE BY MY BEHAVIOR; You are to act as Christian “role models” for our younger children. No foul or crude language. Come wearing proper attire. Bring with you a **POSITIVE ATTITUDE** each day. No sitting out during an activity. You need to set an example for the campers by gladly participating. Your break time is your lunch time. You are involved with campers at all other times.

I WILL ADHERE TO THE DRESS CODE: Wear the camp t-shirt every day. No exposed midriffs. No short shorts. Wear tennis shoes and socks. No sandals or bare feet. Minimal jewelry. Earrings in ears only. No visible tattoos. No black lipstick or fingernails. No unnatural hair color.

Being a counselor is an honor and a privilege. It is not a “right”. If you choose to disregard any of the above regulations, you will be asked to leave until the situation can be corrected.

Your main duties of the week will be to help our young campers experience a joyful week learning about Christ, both through our daily activities and lessons, and by being close to nature in the rustic setting of our church campus. Remember at all times, they learn so much by what they see and hear. You set the example either positive or negative. Please try not to show undue favoritism to any of the campers. We want all of our campers to have a positive experience and to look forward to coming back next year. You also act as an aide to the camp leaders: Dean Charlie Camlin, Father Kasey Gage, Deacon Marcus Bell and any other adult who is volunteering his or her time to be with us during the week. **ALL COUNSELORS WILL SPEND ONE DAY WITH THE PRE-SCHOOL GROUP.**
